How do I apply?

To apply for the Quality Company Formations scholarship, you must submit:

- A fully completed student application form
- A 1,000 word essay outlining your business idea (guidance below)
- A copy of a letter of acceptance and/or proof of enrolment at a recognised UK higher learning institution (PDF)

These items must be submitted by no later than 5pm on 30th June 2022 to:

scholarships@qualityformations.co.uk. Applications sent after this date will not be accepted.

In your email message, please include your full name, learning institution and contact details.

What should I include in my essay?

As part of your application, you must submit an essay of no more than 1,000 words outlining your startup proposal, and details of how you would utilise the Quality Company Formations scholarship in order to further develop your idea.

This essay should be submitted as a word document, along with your completed application form and a copy of a letter of acceptance and/or proof of enrolment at a recognised UK higher learning institution.

In your essay, please be sure to include:

- Your full name and learning institution
- An essay title
- A description of your business idea, how it came about and what steps you have already taken to develop this idea
- A brief explanation why you should be named one of this year's winners
- Details on how you would utilise the grant funds if your application was successful

Please use a neat, legible font (preferably 11pt Calibri or 12pt Times New Roman).
